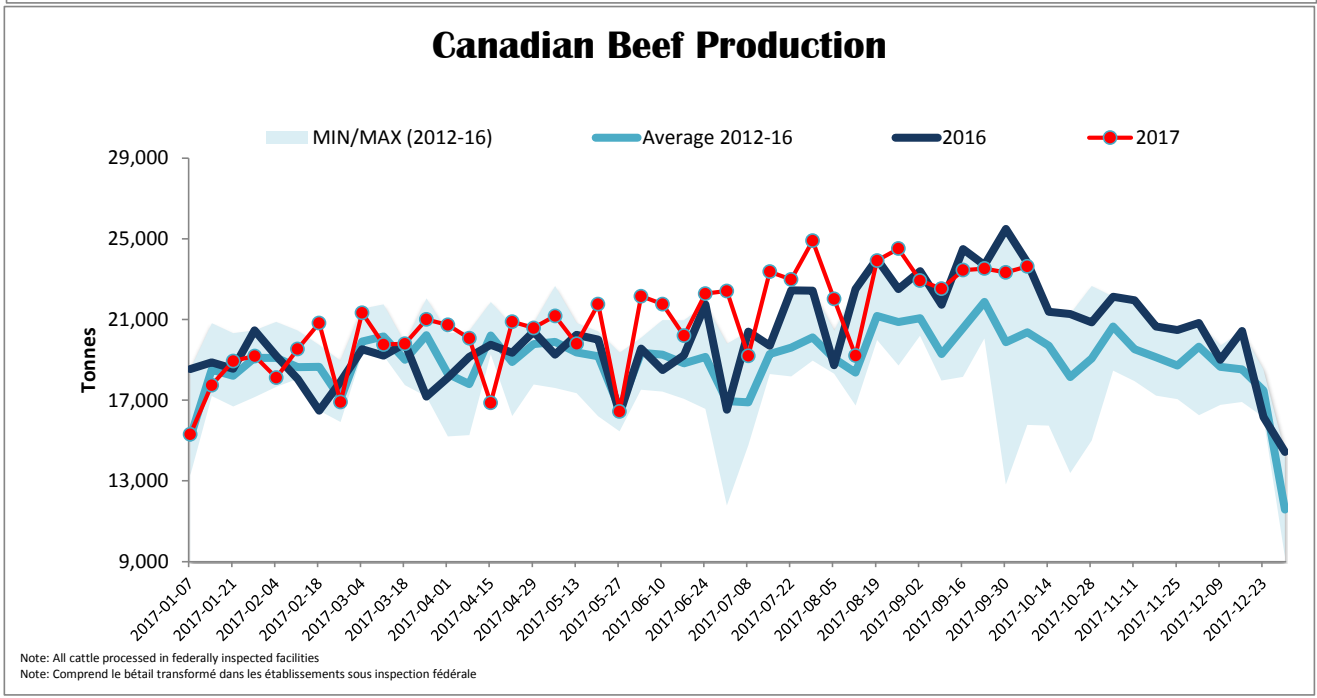
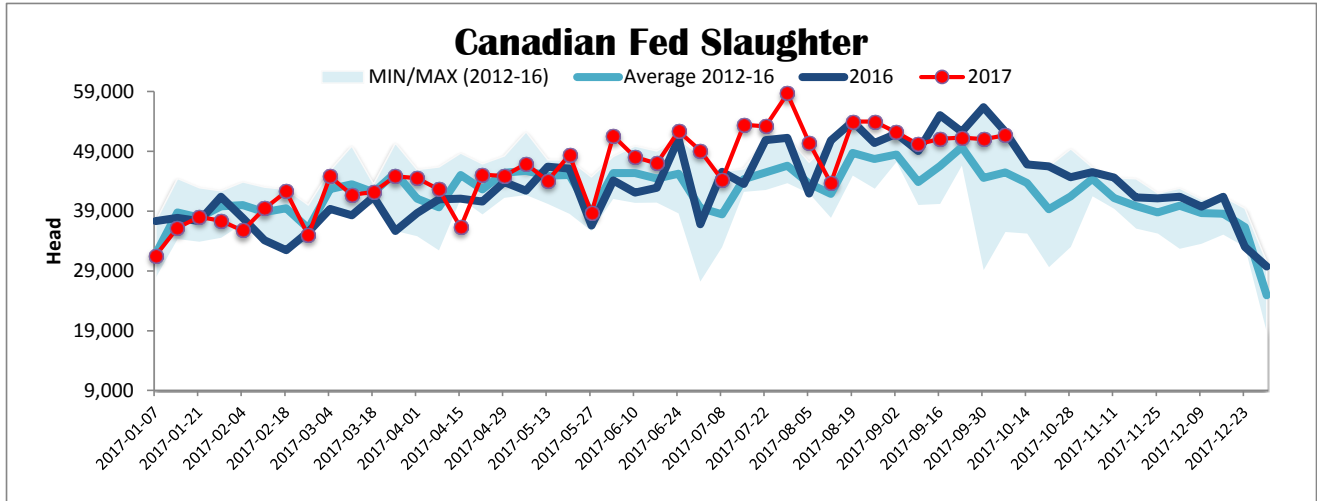

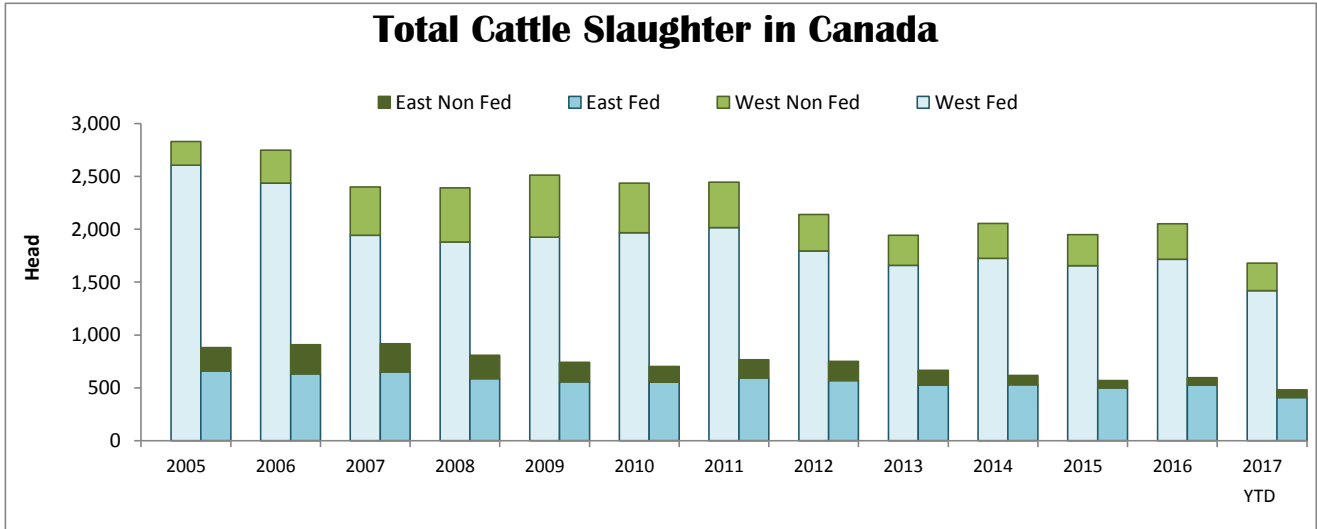


Year to Date for the Week Ending October 7, 2017
