



Tournaments at Deer Creek

GENERAL: What You Need to Know

- Our Clubhouse will remain closed during this time except for grab and go food and beverage, and washrooms.
- All payments for group bookings and tournaments will be invoiced to the organizer who is responsible for paying the confirmed number of players. Group bookings and tournaments do not permit individual payment.
- When at Deer Creek, RESPECT all fellow golfers by physical distancing and by not touching anything on the course besides your own belongings.
- Anytime a customer approaches any of our staff members (golf operations employees, Food and beverage employees, Turf Maintenance employees) a mask MUST be worn.

ARRIVAL: What You Need to Know

- Tournament participants are asked to arrive no longer than 20 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
- Power carts will be staged (unless specified otherwise) and cannot be taken to the parking lot to retrieve your belongings.
- The self serve bag drop area is located on the South side of the building. Once you drop your clubs off, please proceed to the parking lot to park your vehicle.

POWER CARTS: What You Need to Know

- The Government of Ontario now mandates that anyone NOT from the same household to wear a mask while riding in the power cart. Deer Creek provides a single cart rider fee. Single riders must be prearranged prior to day of play and are based on availability.

REGISTRATION: What You Need to Know

- Registration tables will be provided by Deer Creek. Tournament representatives that are responsible for the registration table are required to always wear a mask and ensure that tournament participants are socially distanced when registering.

VOLUNTEERS: What You Need to KNOW

- All volunteers must follow all of Deer Creek Golf Clubs safety protocols. A mask must always be worn when approaching tournament participants and physical distancing must be maintained.

During Play: What You Need to Know

- Your safety and the safety of our staff is our priority. Always maintain a safe distance (2 Meters) from all playing partners.
- Leave the pin in at all times.
- No shaking of hands, high-fiving, or hugging is permitted.
- If vendors are present on the golf course, they must abide by all Deer Creek Golf Clubs safety protocols and wear a mask at all times. If sampling of any food and beverage is present on the course, participants are required to wear a mask while approaching the vendor and the vendor representative is required to wear a mask and all other government mandated PPE.

After Your Round: What You Need to Know

- DO NOT LOITER IN THE PARKING LOT BEFORE OF AFTER YOUR ROUND AS SAFETY REMAINS OUR #1 PRIORITY.
