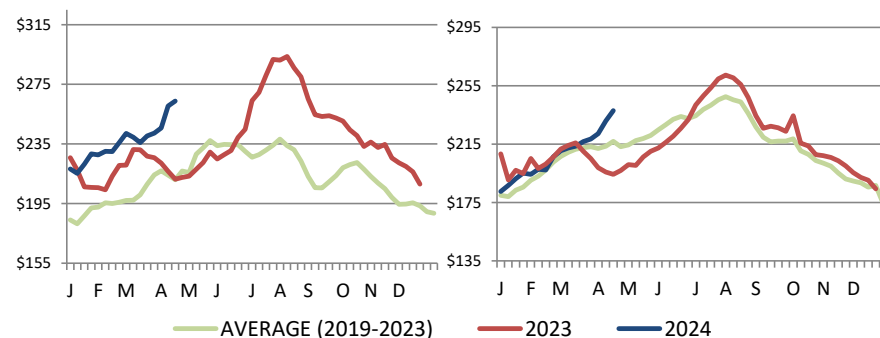

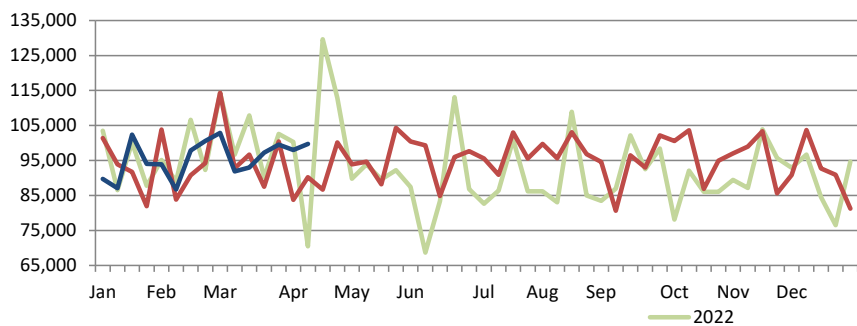

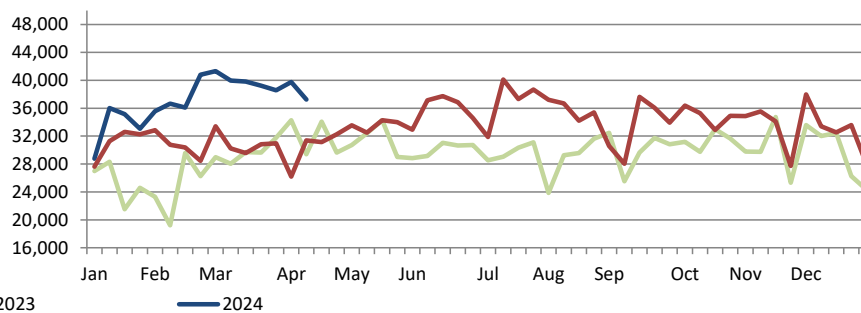

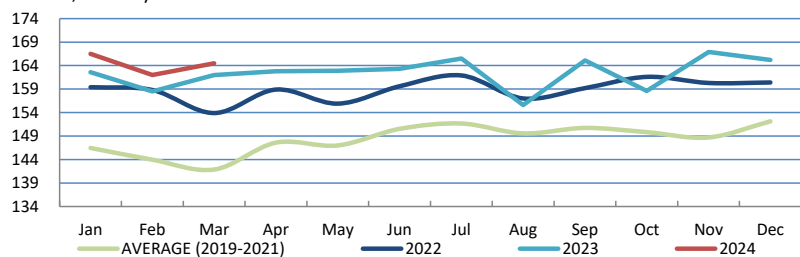

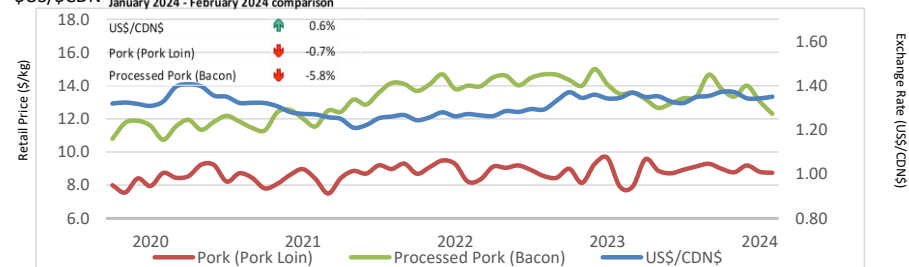

### Exchange Rate and Retail Prices for Pork Products

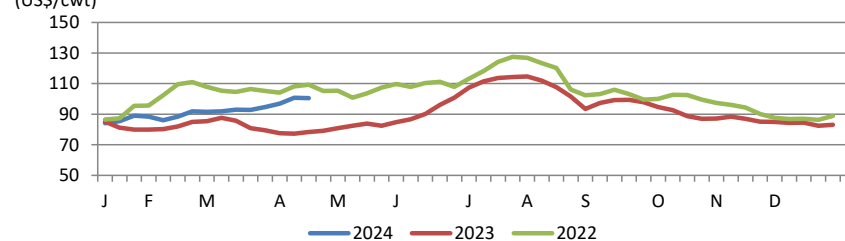
